Evidence:

We may not be able to re-calculate your entitlement without supporting evidence of your changed circumstances. If you are unable to supply evidence with this form it can be sent later.

Your payments of Housing Benefit may be stopped while we wait for your evidence. We will write to you about this. If you fail to supply information we may end your award.

Acceptable evidences include:-

Where there is a change to the people that live in your home we can accept:

A Birth Certificate, a Marriage Certificate or a Civil Partnership Certificate, Passport, National Insurance Card, Drivers Licence, UK Residence Permit, EEC Identity Card.

Where there is a change to the benefits, income, earnings and or capital coming into you home we can accept:

- Current benefit award notices or a letter from the Department for Work and Pensions confirming the amount
- Pension slips from a former employer
- For recent employment or change to earnings the wage slips you have available and or a contract
 of employment detailing the expected future earnings
- Consecutive wage slips; either five weekly or two monthly or an Earnings Certificate
- For recent self-employment a self-employed form, giving a projection of earnings. For longer term self-employment either your self-employed audited accounts or an Income and Expenditure form. You can get copies of the forms by telephoning 01636 650000.
- Up to date Bank, Building Society or Post Office books, full bank statements of which we need evidence for at least the last two consecutive months, Premium Bonds, National Savings Certificates, ISA's, Stocks, Shares and Unit Trusts.

Changes in rent:

Your Tenancy Agreement, a letter from your landlord or a Landlord Rent Declaration Form.

Change of Address:

We may need you to complete an additional form about your new home and the way in which you would like to receive your Housing Benefit. We will send you a form if it is needed.

We need evidence about your new rent. If you have any other changes of circumstances occurring at the same time you move house we will need evidence of that change as well.
