**The Dog Control Orders (Prescribed Offences and Penalties, etc.) Regulations 2006  
(S.I.2006/1059)**

**The Dogs on Leads (Newark and Sherwood District) Order 2010**

The Newark and Sherwood District Council (“the Council”) hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order comes into force on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2010.
2. This Order applies to the land specified in the Schedule.

**Offence**

- 3(1) A person in charge of a dog shall be guilty of an offence if, at any time, on any land to which this Order applies he does not keep the dog on a lead, unless—
- (a) he has a reasonable excuse for failing to do so; or
  - (b) the owner, occupier or other person or authority having control of the land has consented (generally or specifically) to his failing to do so.
- (2) For the purposes of this article a person who habitually has a dog in his possession shall be taken to be in charge of the dog at any time unless at that time some other person is in charge of the dog.

**Penalty**

4. A person who is guilty of an offence under article 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale.

## SCHEDULE

1. Subject to the exception in paragraph 11 below all land described in the following Schedule and shown for indicative purposes outlined and cross hatched in red on the attached maps, being land that lies within the administrative area of the Council which is;
  - (i) open to the air(which includes land that is covered but open on at least one side); and
  - (ii) to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access (with or without payment); and
  - (iii) is signed as “dogs on leads area” (whether the sign uses those particular words or words and/or symbols having like effect).

2. Mount Road Cemetery, Balderton
3. Lakeside, Balderton
4. Playground to the rear of 90 to 96 Henton Road, Edwinstowe
5. Village Green, Main Street, Fiskerton cum Morton
6. Riverside Footpath, Fiskerton cum Morton
7. Halam Churchyard, Church Lane, Halam
8. London Road Cemetery, Newark
9. Village Hall, Staythorpe Road, Rolleston
10. Playing Field behind ex Minster School, Church Street, Southwell
11. Excepted from the description in paragraph 1 above is land placed at the disposal of the Forestry Commissioners under section 39(1) of the Forestry Act 1967.
