

NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

Referendum on the adoption of the Fernwood Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on **THURSDAY 28 SEPTEMBER 2017** to decide on the question below:

'Do you want Newark and Sherwood District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Fernwood to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'

2. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on **TUESDAY 12 SEPTEMBER 2017**. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
3. Postal vote applications, amendments or cancellations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Kelham Hall, Kelham, Newark, Nottinghamshire, NG23 5QX by 5pm on **WEDNESDAY 13 SEPTEMBER 2017**.
4. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Kelham Hall, Kelham, Newark, Nottinghamshire, NG23 5QX by 5pm on **WEDNESDAY 20 SEPTEMBER 2017**. Requests for changes to existing proxy vote arrangements and cancellations must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on **WEDNESDAY 13 SEPTEMBER 2017**.
5. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer, Kelham Hall, Kelham, Newark, Nottinghamshire, NG23 5QX by 5pm on **THURSDAY 28 SEPTEMBER 2017**. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on **WEDNESDAY 20 SEPTEMBER 2017**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on **WEDNESDAY 20 SEPTEMBER 2017**.
