WHEREAS on the 7th day of September 1984, you made application for a site licence variation in respect of land situated and appertaining to Caravan Site, Carlton Manor, Ossington Road, Carlton on Trent, Nottinghamshire (hereinafter called "the said land").

AND WHEREAS you are entitled to the benefit of permission (ref. No. E/34/49) for the use of the said land as a caravan site granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1962, otherwise than by a development order.

NOW THEREFORE the Newark and Sherwood District Council

HEREBY GRANT a site licence in respect of the said land pursuant to Section 3 of the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960, subject to the following conditions, that is to say

1. The holder of the site licence is to comply with the conditions laid down in the current edition of Model Standards for both Permanent Residential and Touring Caravan Sites (copies attached).
2. This licence is issued with the condition that at any one time the number of caravans on the site is not to exceed Ten Residential Caravans and Ten Tourist Caravans.
3. The holder of the Site Licence is to comply with the requirements of the County Fire Officer.
