38/18	<p>Open Session</p> <p>Cllr Sue Saddington (Notts CC) Reported that reluctantly that the County Council budget would be increased by 4.99% of which 2.99% is for the general running of the Council , the additional 2% is for Social Care. An extra £20m was approved over the next 4 years to repair the highways within villages and housing developments.</p> <p>The answer to question regarding the box on the road, raised at the last meeting, is that the box at the side of the road as traffic enters Rolleston village from Staythorpe is a permanent traffic counter recording traffic flows and vehicle speeds.</p> <p>Regarding the problem with the traffic light failure on the A617, the answer is that it was repaired as soon as it was reported a second time and correctly classified as urgent.</p> <p>General Public</p> <p>A member of the public expressed concern about the loud bird scarers situated near footpaths. Also a view was expressed that the Parish Council should use the 2 acre field as a burial ground. This would save money as the Parish Council would not donate money to the church to purchase the strip of land.</p>
