VACANCY FOR THREE PARISH COUNCILLORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, following the local elections on 4 May 2019, three vacancies exist in the office of Parish Councillor for Rufford Parish Council.

The councillors will consider the co-option of councillors to these vacancies at its meeting at 5.30 pm on Tuesday 16 July 2019 in the Markham Suite, Rufford Mill, Rufford.

To be eligible for co-option, a person must

- Be at least 18 years old
- Be a British citizen, an eligible Commonwealth citizen or a citizen of any member state of the European Union, and
- Meet at least **one** of the following four qualifications:
 - a. Be registered as a local government elector for Rufford parish
 - b. Have occupied as owner or tenant any land or other premises in Rufford parish during the whole of the 12 months before the day of your nomination and the day of election.
 - c. Have an address in Rufford parish as your main or only place of work during the previous 12 months
 - d. Have lived in Rufford parish or within three miles of it during the whole of the previous 12 months

Any person interested in becoming a parish councillor should apply by email before 4 pm on Monday 15 July 2019 to the clerk at ruffordparishclerk@gmail.com giving the following information:

4. The basis on which you are meet the eligibility qualifications
5. Reasons for wanting to join the parish council
