Are you Bin smart?

Nottinghamshire County Council, your local District or Borough Council and Veolia Environmental Services are all working in partnership to increase the amount of household waste that is recycled. But in order to do this we need your help!

This guide has been created to let you know how you can do your bit to increase recycling rates by ensuring that the right waste goes in to the right bin – in short becoming **'Bin Smart!'**

What happens to my recyclable waste?



Recyclable materials are collected from the kerbside by your local council.

They are then taken to a Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) in Mansfield. This is where your recycling is sorted and bundled before being sent on to companies that will recycle the materials to make new products.

However, for the MRF to work at its best, we need to reduce contamination in the recycling we collect from you. Contamination is when the wrong thing goes into the wrong bin.

The machinery can also work much more effectively at sorting, if your recyclables are clean, dry and loose when they go into your wheeled bin instead of being placed inside bags or boxes.

Why do I need to get Bin Smart?

- It's really important to find out the recycling dos and don'ts in your local area. If we recycle properly then local recycling rates can increase and the amount of waste that goes to landfill can be reduced.
- Labels on packaging can sometimes be misleading and make you think that certain items can or can't go into your recycling bin.
- If the wrong items are put into your recycling bin, they can end up damaging the machinery at the MRF.
- If there are too many wrong items in our recyclables, the whole load could end up in landfill, wasting everyone's efforts.

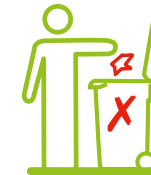

Please take your lids off and put them in your general waste bin. Lids are sometimes made from a different plastic and are often a different colour to the plastic bottle.

Glass
