Newark and Sherwood District Council provides social housing to over 5500 tenants across the district; including general housing, supported housing and housing with care and support.

What is the Community Chest Fund?

The Community Chest Fund is designed to give residents of Newark & Sherwood and NSDC staff the opportunity to identify areas that may be made better, safer, cleaner, and greener by the injection of a small amount of funding up to £1000.

The money is provided from the Housing Revenue Account so must be spent on improving the amenities of social housing tenants or areas which social housing tenants use.

Essential Criteria:

- The project is in a community where Newark and Sherwood District Council housing is represented.
- The application must demonstrate demand for the project in the local community.
- The application must be supported by and made in consultation with NSDC tenants.
- The application must demonstrate how it aligns with the current NSDC Community Plan.
- The project must be inclusive and accessible to all.
- The project must show that value for money will be achieved.
- The project must be delivered within 12 months of award.

COMMUNITY CHEST GUIDELINES - 2024/25

The grant funding size

Up to £1000 per application

Who can apply?

- NSDC tenants and leaseholders
- NSDC residents (if they can prove their project will significantly benefit tenants and leaseholders)
- NSDC elected members
- NSDC staff officers

The grant will not support:

- Core funding or general running costs
- Professional fees
- Building or capital work
- Political or religious activities
- Commercial Organisations
- Work considered to be a statutory responsibility

How the funding is administered:

- The Tenant Engagement Community Chest Panel will consider each application in line with these guidelines.
- Once a decision is made applicants will receive an email advising of the next steps.
- NSDC officer applicants will be responsible for ordering goods/ services through approved suppliers and providing receipts.
- In cases where funding is requested to 'match fund' a project, funding may be provided once approved, to properly constituted groups or organisations' which can verify who the beneficiaries are, and the application is supported by tenants or leaseholders.
- Internal applicants—funding will be spent by Newark and Sherwood District Council.
- External applicants—funding will be paid to approved external applicants bank accounts.
- Applicants are requested to promote their successful award as widely as possible.
- Photographs: Applicants are asked to provide a minimum of 2 post project completion photographs for inclusion in NSDC promotional material.
