The Parish Council were disappointed **not** to be unable to provide positive comments of support for the approach which has been taken in the Amended Policy Documents.

The District Council has previously had a clear strategy in place for allocations and employment which is on/ahead of target for the current plan period.

This amendment principally deals with the allocation for gypsy roma/travellers, which has previously been less robust in strategy terms and has resulted in some less than ideal permissions being granted as a result, this is a welcome alteration especially as this approach appears to be deliverable by the District Council.
