Sustainability Appraisals (SA) are a requirement of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 and Strategic Environmental Assessments (SEA) are required by European Directive EC/2001/42, which was transposed into UK law by the Environmental Assessment Regulations for Plans and Programmes (July 2004). The EqIA is a way of demonstrating the District Council is fulfilling the requirements of the Public Sector Equality Duty contained in section 149 of the Equality Act 2010. HIA is a recognised process for considering the health impacts of plans and undertaking this type of assessment is widely seen as best practice.

Proposing to amend policies in the Core Strategy through a review of the DPD raises concerns. The Core Strategy contains strategic policies which are not found in the Allocations and DM DPD. The consultation on the plan review is clearly badged as relating to the DPD; as such parties interested only in strategic policies in the Core Strategy may reasonably have chosen not to look at this DPD consultation. The proposed review of Core Policies 1 and 3, together with creating a new Core Policy 2A should have been taken forward as a limited scope review of the Core Strategy in line with paragraph 33 of the NPPF.
A Local Development Scheme is required under section 15 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended).
