### Second Publication Amended Allocations and Development Management DPD - September 2023

#### Representations on Policy GRT4 and Site Allocation OB/GRT/6

Please find attached completed representation form in respect of the above, which is submitted on behalf of our client, Mr Heath Fury – a locally operating traveller who owns land east of Newark Road, Ollerton, which has been identified for allocation as a new traveller site for around 6 pitches under Policy GRT4 (site reference OB/GRT/6).

As the representation form is primarily geared towards objections, rather than representations in support (as all of the boxes for representations only appear relevant if you are objecting) they are necessarily scant.

However, for the avoidance of any doubt, our client's formal position now is that he is **fully** supportive of the inclusion of his site as a traveller site allocation under Policy GRT4 and site allocation reference OB/GRT/6.

Your consultation document asks for confirmation as to whether previous representations should be forwarded to the Inspector, or superseded by representations made in respect of this Second Publication Draft.

Our previous representations objected to the Plan as drafted, owing to the omission of our client's site which we believed resulted in local under-provision relative to the identified needs. It was apparent that the only reason our client's site was omitted as an allocation in the previous draft was in the absence of details demonstrating the provision of a satisfactory access. Our previous representations included such access details and sought the allocation of the site

The Second Publication Draft has clearly taken our previous representations into account and allocated the site as sought.

This all being the case, our previous objection can be withdrawn – and it will obviously no longer be necessary to attend the Examination in Public to further that objection orally.

Please therefore could you ensure the Inspector is aware of our client's support for both Policy GRT4 and site reference OB/GRT/6.

Finally, thank you for evidently taking our previous representations into account – which reinforces the worth of these consultation stages.
