
Notice of Election

Election of a Member of Parliament for the

Sherwood Forest Constituency

Notice is hereby given that:

1. An election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for the Sherwood Forest Constituency.
2. **Nomination Papers**
Nomination papers may be obtained from the Acting Returning Officer, Castle House, Great North Road, Newark, NG24 1BY, who will at the request of any elector prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. **Delivery of Nomination Papers**
Nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer, Castle House, Great North Road, Newark, NG24 1BY, on any day after the date of this notice between 10am and 4pm, but not later than **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.

The £500 deposit can be paid by legal tender, by means of a banker's draft from a drawer which carries on business as a banker in the United Kingdom or by electronic funds (if paid on or before Thursday 6 June 2024).

4. **Poll**
If an election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**.
5. **Register of Electors**
If you are not registered to vote or you have recently moved address, the last day to apply to register to be included on the register used for this election is Tuesday 18 June 2024.
6. **Absent Voters**
Electors and their proxies should take note that new applications to vote by post, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (or the Electoral Registration Officer for your area of the constituency) by 5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024, if they are to be effective for this election. This also includes electors and their proxies who wish to make alterations to their existing arrangements.

Applications to appoint a proxy (someone to vote on your behalf) must reach the Electoral Registration Officer (or to the Electoral Registration Officer for your area of the constituency) by 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024, if they are to be effective for this election. If you have become unable to vote in person since the deadline to apply to appoint a proxy at 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024 because of either illness, due to employment, or based on photo ID, you can apply for an emergency proxy, in which case applications may be made until 5pm on election day.

All applications and notices regarding absent voting, must be sent to the Electoral Registration Officer, Castle House, Great North Road, Newark, NG24 1BY (or to the Electoral Registration Officer for your area of the constituency).
