### **Parish Council January 22**

Re Min 4337.a1 Priory Close Grassed Area The County Council's Forestry Department is considering the suggestion of planting trees on the grassed area to prevent it being used as a vehicular access.

### **Amenities Committee February**

Re Minute 3376 Heron Way Car Park The residents who deploy the barriers at the car park have been asked for their suggestions regarding the best times to close the car park overnight.

Re Minute 3380 Outdoor Gym Equipment Copies of possible options are circulated for members perusal.

### **Planning Committee February**

Re Minute 0598 Land off Main Street A taller fence has been installed to a section of the former Gypsy site on Main Street. The Planning Enforcement Department is aware of this and enquiries are being made.

Re Min 0600.e Flowserve Development Robert Jenrick M.P. has responded, advising that a Section 106 agreement and Community Infrastructure Levy (C.I.L.) funding was not secured for the residential development because the site falls within a zero-rated zone for C.I.L. and the developer could not viably provide Section 106 contributions.
