	Public Participation: A member of public addressed the PC regarding their correspondence about pollution in the field ditch near The Bothy; this was noted by the PC who will pass on to the Environmental Agency.

21/072	Declarations of interest: There were no declarations of interest.
21/073	Minutes of the previous meeting: Minutes from the meeting held on 8 th September 2021 were accepted as a true record and signed by the Chairman.
21/074	Matters arising: Village sign: Clerk to chase £400 from BL. A site meeting with VIA is arranged for Thursday 14 th October to confirm location and complete documentation for permission. It was agreed to remove the strap line and use Cllr Laughton's contribution for installation (the extra £100 required to cover the cost of installation will come from BKVC fund). Green House permission was received from S. Michael.
21/075	Reports from District and County Councillors: Cllr Saddington informed the PC that District is liaising with the Environmental Health regarding the piped ditches that are adjacent to The Bothy. CJ shared his concerns regarding the apparent inconsistencies in the Conservation Officers decision making criteria on planning applications. CJ asked Cllr Laughton about the possible resurfacing of Norwell Road and Mill Lane through Caunton as it is breaking up badly; Cllr Laughton advised writing to Shaun Brown or Jo Horton to request it is included in the future programme. <i>(members of public and Cllr Laughton and Cllr Saddington left at 19h57).</i>
