

6.	<p>Budget and Precept. The clerk presented the budget for 2023-2024. There is a potential cost from the upcoming elections on May 4th, the size of which depends on whether there is a need for a Parish Council election. £1000 should be reserved for this.</p> <p>Additional expenses are expected due to the Parish Council having rented land at Lamb's Field and School Field.</p> <p>A question was asked by a member of the public, wishing to know why the Council were paying £300 a year to rent Lamb's Field. This was discussed and it was explained that this was to give the public a community open space, which is currently used for the community orchard and has also been used for events in the past.</p> <p>It was agreed that it would be good to find more ways to use this in the future.</p> <p>The precept figure was discussed. A vote was held and the precept was increased from £11000 to £11500 an increase of ~ 4.5%. This is below inflation and considers the expected expenses of the election.</p>	
7.	<p>Road Closure at Greaves Lane. The clerk informed the Parish Council of a road closure at Greaves Lane on 8th February. Details can be found on the via website.</p>	
8.	<p>Children's Play Area - Maintenance. The clerk presented the monthly maintenance inspections. No major issues, but there is a continual need to check and tighten bolts as required.</p>	
public	<p>The chair opened the meeting to the public. A member of the public reported an issue with noisy dogs on Station Road. This is a repeat of a previous issue and enforcement are aware. Clerk will follow up with enforcement.</p> <p>There have been complaints about the area around the nursing home on Station Road due to the construction works which are ongoing.
