#### 5 Matters arising

The clerk had received a revised invoice from NSDC for Dog Bin waste collection of £137.28 for 6-month period. A letter had recently been sent to Mr R Dalton regarding digging out silt from the Dyke and is awaiting his response

6 to receive questions and petitions from members of the public – for information only

3 members of the pupil were present who had a number of questions about Flooding on Eakring Road from the Dyke – covered at item 13 on the agenda, and the closure of the foot Bridge between the Play Park and Millenium Gardens – covered at item 9

#### 7 Reports from the District and County Councillors

**County** – Cllr Carlton reported that the Resurfacing work on the A616 in Wellow is scheduled for 8/1/24 to 18/1/24, and that the lines would be re-instated from The School Room.

In preparation for the A614 works ANPR are collecting information in order to determine most appropriate routes at that time. An interactive speed sign is to be installed outside the Red Lion. Trading standards have been monitoring HGVs on Eakring Rd and have issued one fine for inappropriate use of the road. The decision on the Rufford Ford closure is imminent.

N.C.C. funding will re-opening - Capital Funding up to £20,000 and Revenue Funding up to £5000

District – Cllr Tift introduced Cllr Penny as this was her first visit to Wellow and said that they would be alternating attendance to our meetings in the future but are both working to represent Wellow

Cllr Penny reported that NSDC community grant £20,000 was re opening. NSDC had been successful in Obtaining £20 million from the Levelling Up Fund from Central Government for use in projects at Ollerton and Clipstone

## 10 Bridge to Millenium Gardens closure due to safety concerns and next step Dismantling - Consider estimates for removal

#### Costs of a New Bridge - consider options

Quotes for new bridges

Garden Bridge Co Ltd £7085 new bridge and delivery

Henry Beaver £10,000 plus VAT new bridge and delivery ;

both have additional costs for installation

Secure a Field offer a complete installation service and would be in the region of £20-£25k + VAT

Questions by the public – couldn't the bridge be repaired? had we obtained a professional survey of bridge safety? Isn't there a right of way? Isn't it a footpath? What funding is available to put in a new bridge? It was reported that Dog walkers using Millenium Garden are pleased that the Foot Bridge is closed so they can let their dogs off the lease as no fear of them entering the Children's Play Park.

Could a ramp pathway be made into the Millenium garden instead of having a bridge?

The clerk reported that there were various types of funding available but some of this was match funding or would need repaying over 5years e.g. Lottery Grants. NSDC capital grant funding opens in the Spring It was clear that a lot of work needs to be done on this project, one member of the public had already offered to assist the Parish Council with this. The clerk suggested that a working party be set up and all three members of the public present agreed to join this.

Clerk to contact them to set up a meeting. In the mean time the clerk would contact NSDC/VIA to see if they could provide someone to survey the bridge – this is expected that this will be at a cost

#### 11 Play Park - consider viability of request for Cycle Track / Path

The council considered that the Play Park should remain Cycle free, and that installation of a track would go against the covenant on the land

Despite the Dyke having been cleared, whenever there has been heavy rain Debris from leaves and twigs wash down into the grid at Eakring Rd and cause a blockage leading to the Dyke to over flow. Removing the grid was discussed but this would then allow silt and debris to collect in the pipe under the road blocking this permanently.

At present a resident is raking out the debris once a week
