Also known as a lifeline service, Careline can support you to live independently in your home, knowing there is always someone there to answer your call and provide peace of mind for you and your family and friends.

It can be used to raise an alarm call from anywhere in your home. Simply press your Careline pendant, or the large red button on the main unit to call for assistance.

Careline is monitored by our locally based, trained, and professional staff 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year. If you need urgent assistance or are worried, we're just a push of the button away and we will get you the assistance that you need.
